OVERSIZED ITEMS (OSI) COLLECTION

- Your OSI (bulk waste) collection has been completed for 2026
- In 2027, OSI collection will be by appointment
- One collection per household, per year
- Booking and collection dates will be posted on our website and shared through Voyent Alert

Household Garbage/Recycling:

Garbage: Use clear garbage bags only.

Recyclables: Use recycling blue bags only. No limit on number of blue bags that can be set out on scheduled recycling days.

Privacy Bags: Optional — residents may place out one opaque (non-transparent) plastic bag per week for personal items such as sanitary or incontinence products.

Bag Limit: The total number of garbage bags, including privacy bag if one is used, must not exceed five bags per week.

Curbside Placement: Set bags out by 7 a.m. Place them within 4.5 m (15 ft) of the pavement or road-side.

Bag Weight: Maximum 20 kg (45 lbs) per bag.

Bundle Length: Max. 1.5 m (4 ft) for bundled items.

Secure Bags: Tie bags securely to prevent spillage.

Tagging: Bags that do not meet collection guidelines will be tagged with an orange sticker indicating the reason(s) for non-collection. Once corrected, the waste will be collected on the next scheduled collection day.

Not Accepted: Oversized (bulk waste) items, and hazardous waste.

Non-Waste Items: Keep non-waste items, like bicycles and children's toys, away from collection area.

Missed/Delayed Collections:

Service Delays: Collections may be delayed due to weather, mechanical issues, or staffing shortages. Report missed collections to ERSB directly at info@ersbnl.ca, or call (709) 579-7960 / Toll free (877) 878-2166.

Service Prioritization: Garbage collection may be prioritized over recycling collection during service disruptions.

Collection Updates: Check our website, or follow us on **Voyent Alert**, a free notification service for collection changes and reminders. Only an email address or phone number is required to receive alerts. Sign up here: <http://register.voyent-alert.com>.

Garbage Box Maintenance:

Upkeep: Keep garbage boxes clean, in good repair, and free of snow or debris. Boxes with maggots, wasp nests, or evidence of vermin will not be serviced.

Container Standards: Waste will not be collected from makeshift boxes (e.g., old freezers). Unsuitable containers will be tagged to alert owner.

Garbage Box Lids: Residents are responsible for closing garbage box lids after each collection.
