



COMMUNITY CLEANUP PROGRAM CHECKLIST

■ Waste Limits & Scheduling

- ✓ Community cleanups are for removal of litter and debris from public spaces only (No household, commercial, or recyclable waste)
- ✓ One (1) cleanup event per community per year
- ✓ Maximum: 20 pickup truck loads
- ✓ Notify Kevin Butt, Facility & Fleet Manager, at least 7 business days before your cleanup date:

■ Group & Contact Information Required

- ✓ Name of the organizing community
- ✓ Name & mobile number of the lead organizer
- ✓ License plate numbers of all vehicles accessing the facility

■ Waste Disposal Guidelines

- ✓ Organizers are responsible for all collected waste, including items not accepted at the facility
- ✓ Use clear, standard-size bags for litter (No blue bags or black bags accepted)
- ✓ All waste must be dropped off in one day (No extensions)

■ Facility Operating Hours

- ✓ Waste must be dropped off on scheduled date during these regular facility hours:
 - 🕒 Tuesdays & Thursdays: 12:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.*
 - 🕒 Saturdays: 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. (Closed for lunch: 11:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.)*
- *Gates close 15 minutes before closing time

■ Facility Access & Compliance

- ✓ Follow site attendant instructions
- ✓ Wait in line—no skipping
- ✓ Offload materials by hand
- ✓ Sort waste as required (e.g., separate metals)
- ⊘ Access will be denied if:
 - ✗ Waste is from non-cleanup sources
 - ✗ Waste includes prohibited materials
 - ✗ Volunteers fail to follow instructions

✓ Accepted Waste:

- Furniture
- Tires (without rims)
- Metals
- Bagged litter (non-biodegradable)
- Construction materials

⊘ Prohibited Waste:

- ✗ Food waste
- ✗ Commercial waste
- ✗ Household hazardous waste
- ✗ Special, regulated, or liquid waste
- ✗ Fishing gear
