They had a busy summer and this Fall they have been visiting schools, doing extra patrols in school zones and staff training has been ongoing. There is continuous movement of staff out and new staff in the detachments.

MHA Parsley thanked everyone for the opportunity to attend and reported that she was busy working for the district and is available at any time.

MHA Parsons stated that she was glad to be back to the meetings after the summer break and mentioned the decision to reverse the closure of the Harbour Grace Court. . The House reopens in November and both her and MHA Parsley will assist in getting Cabinet members to our meetings. School bussing is a major issue at the moment and they are working on it.
